AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION AND HOSTING OF THE INCODE FINANCIAL SOFTWARE SUITE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$115,000 FOR A PERIOD OF SEVEN YEARS

The Board finds that:

It is the responsibility of the Board of Directors to manage SAM's finances in an efficient manner and in compliance with Generally Accepted Accounting Practices (GAAP).

The current processes and procedures are inefficient and create a dependency upon third-party service providers, which can create inconsistent service delivery of accounting transactions.

SAM is a member of the National Joint Powers Alliance, which is a national agency that uses the combined purchasing power of its members to reduce the cost of procurement and provides an industry approved alternative to the individual agency RFP process.

Staff has experience with the Incode financial software suite and Tyler Technologies, a system that will reduce the dependency on third-party service providers and allow the financial processes and procedures to be more efficient and cost effective.

As a result, the Board of Directors of the Sewer Authority Mid-Coastside authorizes the General Manager to execute agreements with Tyler Technologies for the implementation and hosting of the Incode financial software suite in an amount not to exceed \$115,000 for a period of seven years.
