RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT PROVIDING FOR THE PARTICIPATION OF THE PUBLIC AGENCY IN THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAKING ITS EMPLOYEES MEMBERS OF SAID SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law provides for the participation of Public Agency in the Public Employees' Retirement System, making its employees members of said system, and

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF DIRECTORS of (Name of Governing Body) SEWER AUTHORITY MID-COASTSIDE (Name of Public Agency)

on June 13, 19 83, adopted a Resolution giving notice of intention to approve a contract providing for such participation, and

WHEREAS, the employees of said Agency, whose memberships in said Retirement System are contemplated, have approved said participation, by majority vote,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that said BOARD OF DIRECTORS (Name of Governing Body) authorizes, and it does hereby authorize a contract between said

BOARD OF DIRECTORS (Name of Governing Body) and the Board of Administration, Public Employees' Retirement System, a copy of said contract being attached hereto marked Exhibit "A" and by such reference made a part hereof as though herein set out in full, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the presiding officer of said BOARD (Name of OF DIRECTORS) be, and he is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute said contract for and on behalf of SEWER AUTHORITY MID-COASTSIDE (Name of Public Agency)

CONTRACT
BETWEEN THE
BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION
PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM
AND THE
BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE
SEWER AUTHORITY MID-COASTSIDE

In consideration of the covenants and agreement hereafter contained and on the part of both parties to be kept and performed, the governing body of above public agency, hereafter referred to as "Public Agency", and the Board of Administration, Public Employees' Retirement System, hereafter referred to as "Board", hereby agree as follows:

1. All words and terms used herein which are defined in the Public Employees' Retirement Law shall have the meaning as defined therein unless otherwise specifically provided. "Normal retirement age" shall mean age 60 for local miscellaneous members.
2. Public Agency shall participate in the Public Employees' Retirement System from and after July 16, 1983 making its employees as hereinafter provided, members of said System subject to all provisions of the Public Employees' Retirement Law except such as apply only on election of a contracting agency and are not provided for herein and to all amendments to said Law hereafter enacted except such as by express provisions thereof apply only on the election of contracting agencies.
3. Employees of Public Agency in the following classes shall become members of said Retirement System except such in each such class as are excluded by law or this agreement:
 - a. Employees other than local safety members (herein referred to as local miscellaneous members).
4. In addition to the classes of employees excluded from membership by said Retirement Law, the following classes of employees shall not become members of said Retirement System:
 - a. ELECTED OFFICIALS; AND
 - b. ALL EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN LOCAL MISCELLANEOUS.
5. The fraction of final compensation to be provided for each year of credited prior and current service as a local miscellaneous member shall be determined in accordance with Section 21251.13 of said Retirement Law (2% at age 60 Full).

10. Contributions required of Public Agency and its employees shall be paid by Public Agency to the Retirement System within thirty days after the end of the period to which said contributions refer or as may be prescribed by Board regulation. If more or less than the correct amount of contributions is paid for any period, proper adjustment shall be made in connection with subsequent remittances, or adjustments on account of errors in contributions required of any employee may be made by direct cash payments between the employee and the Board. Payments by Public Agency to Board may be made in the form of warrants, bank checks, bank drafts, certified checks, money orders or cash.
